Swiss company Clausek Kran sent in this month's winner. It is a spectacular shot of one of its own cranes, a 60 tonne capacity Liebherr LTR 1060. The tele boom crawler was on its way up the mountain near Zermatt in the shadow of the Matterhorn, from Trockener Steg, at an altitude of 2,923 metres, to its work site at an elevation of 3,100 m. The project is to build the world's highest 3S gondola lift, up the Matterhorn glacier.
